**Sponsors help keep roof on Regina Performing Arts Centre**

Thanks to support from Saskatchewan Credit Unions, various levels of government, and arts foundations, it is no longer raining in the Regina Performing Arts Centre.

The funds received were combined and used to replace part of the roof and two heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units. Work on a third HVAC unit is almost completed.

The Regina Performing Arts Centre is part of the cultural and artistic life of Regina. Thousands of performers appear on RPAC's stage each year and make use of studios, change rooms, and rehearsal areas.

"Thanks to support from sponsors like the City of Regina, artsVest Saskatchewan, Conexus Credit Union, the Lorne and Evelyn Johnson Foundation, and the Community Initiatives Fund, the Regina Performing Arts Centre can continue to provide affordable performance space for Regina's community-based performing arts," said Harvey Linnen, president of Theatre Regina, the not-for-profit group that manages RPAC.
