Vivienne Mort is everyone's adored band of Ukraine's independence music culture. The musicians have released seven albums, the latest of which, "Fata" ("Veil"), received awards in the nomination "Album of the Year" from the country's leading cultural media (Hromadske, Suspilne Kultura, Megogo, etc.). The band's previous album "Experience" was nominated for the Shevchenko Prize, Ukraine's highest national award for significant contribution to the development of culture and art.

In 2024, the song "Chas" ("Time") from this album made it to the top-10 most popular songs in Ukraine on Apple Music.

You will soon be able to hear this song, as well as other iconic songs of the band, such as "Persephone", "Ptashechka" ("Birdie"), "Lety" ("Fly"), and "Slidy Malenkyh Ruk" ("Traces of Small Hands"), at a concert in your city.

Vivienne Mort's music is primarily about the state of mind, existential searches, deep reflections, feelings and experiences. Over the course of its history, the band has experimented a lot with sound: from cabaret to a choir with an organ in a Gothic church. However, the basis of Vivienne Mort's music has always been expressive piano and sensual vocals.

The candlelight tour has already covered eighteen countries, and in 2025 Daniela Zayushkina and her piano will visit Canada for the first time in history!

The fundraising mission of the tour is to purchase service vehicles for the Ukrainian Army.
